In resolution of Charge No. AT-CA-16-0058 (the "Charge") the Department of Justice, Federal Correctional Complex, Butner, North Carolina (the "Agency") and the American Federation of Government Employees, Local 408, (the "Union") agrees as follows:


1. The Agency will post the attached Notice, signed by Chris Holland, the Complex Warden, on bulletin boards where such information is customarily posted at the Federal Medical Center and it will send an e-mail to all bargaining unit employees of the Federal Medical Center. The Notice will remain posted for 60 days.
2. Upon execution of this Agreement, the Union agrees that the Regional Director of the Atlanta Region of the Federal Labor Relations Authority may withdraw the Charge.
