SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Settlement Agreement (“Agreement”) is made by and between the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Prisons, Federal Correctional Complex (“FCC”), Pollock, Louisiana (“Agency”) and the American Federation of Government Employees, Council of Prison Locals #33, Local 1034 (“Union”) in resolution of the grievance (FMCS No. 18- 00301), filed on September 13, 2017, alleging untimely payment of overtime due to the processing of overtime authorization forms for bargaining unit employees (“Grievants”). In full and complete settlement of the above-referenced grievance, the parties by and through their undersigned representative, freely and voluntarily agree to the terms outlined in this Agreement.

1. Without constituting an admission of liability or any wrongdoing upon the part of either the Agency or the Union, the Agency agrees to pay a total of \$552,376.92 to the affected FCC Pollock staff, as outlined in Attachment (1). The Agency

agrees that personnel staff at FCC Pollock will transmit orders to Grand Prairie to begin processing of the payments within 30 days of the signing of this agreement. All payments to bargaining unit staff shall be completed within one hundred twenty (120) days. This payment is in full settlement to resolve all claims in the above cited grievance which pertained to the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA), 29 U.S.C. § 201 et seq; the Federal Employees Pay Act of 1945, as amended (FEPA) 5 U.S.C. §§ 5542, 5546 et seq; or any other pay acts from September 13, 2014, through September 13, 2017. This sum covers all backpay, liquidated damages, and interest which may have been claimed by all present and former bargaining unit employees represented by AFGE Local 1034.

2. The Agency further agrees to pay \$85,000.00 in attorney fees to Whitehead Law Firm, by wire transfer, within 14 days of the signing of this agreement and presentation of Whitehead Law Firm's invoice. This settlement agreement resolves all claims for attorney fees and expenses.
3. The Agency will bear all cancelation fees and expenses due the arbitrator in this matter and pay the same within 14 days of the presentation of Arbitrator Richard Been's invoice.
4. The Union and Grievants covered by this settlement warrant and represent that no other action or suit with respect to the claims that are set forth in the grievance covered by this settlement will be filed in or submitted to any court or any administrative forum including but not limited to the General Accounting Office or the Office of Personnel Management for the time period outlined in this Agreement. By agreeing to accept payment under this settlement, the Union and Grievants agree to waive any right or entitlement to pursue or collect payment for any FLSA claim asserted in the grievance covered by this settlement for the time period September 13, 2014, through September 13, 2017. The Union and Grievants agree they will not litigate or re-litigate in any forum, judicial or administrative, any issues arising from the actions involved in this grievance. This would include waiving any appeal rights to the Merit Systems Protection Board, Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, Federal Labor

Relations Authority, or any other grievance/arbitration claim.

5. The Union, Grievants, and their beneficiaries warrant and represent that they are the sole owners of the claims set forth by the grievance described above and that they have made no assignment or transfer of all or any part of their rights in those claims. The Union, Grievants, and their beneficiaries agree that, should there be any violation of these warranties and representations, all monies paid herein will promptly refunded to the Agency.


The Parties further mutually represent that they made a good faith effort to identify all bargaining unit staff affected by the alleged FLSA claims raised in the grievance as delineated in Attachment 1. Should any bargaining unit staff come forward within thirty (30) days of the signing of this settlement agreement and identify additional FLSA claims which would fall within the scope of the grievance and this settlement agreement, the parties agree to make a good faith effort to verify the accuracy of such claim. Should the parties mutually agree to the accuracy of any additional claim (as described herein), the parties agree that the Agency will pay the said identified additional bargaining unit staff in the same manner as all others involved in this settlement.

6. All parties understand and agree that this settlement releases and forever irrevocably discharges the United States government, the Bureau of Prisons, the Agency and their officers, agents, and employees, and each of them, separately and collectively, from all claims cited in the grievance which pertain to the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA), 29 U.S.C. § 201 et seq; the Federal Employees Pay Act of 1945, as amended (FEPA) 5 U.S.C. §§ 5542, 5544, 5546 et seq; or any other pay acts for the period September 13, 2014, through September 13, 2017. The parties agree that any and all statutes of limitations pertaining to FLSA, FEPA or any other pay acts are met and resolved by this settlement.
7. All parties agree that this Agreement will not be cited as precedent, and may not be cited, published, or referenced by either party as justification for their respective positions or referred to in any other proceeding, whether judicial or administrative, for any purpose other than to enforce the terms of this settlement.

8. No party to this agreement will seek its enforcement until that party first makes a good-faith effort through the other party, or that party's representative, to resolve a difference of interpretation of the terms of the agreement and /or have the other party cure an asserted failure of performance of the terms of the agreement.
9. This Agreement constitutes the complete terms of the settlement and supersedes any and all prior oral and written representations, understanding, or agreements between the parties to this settlement. There are no other terms, expressed or implied, except those written in this settlement.
10. The parties acknowledge that this agreement consists of eleven (11) paragraphs on four (4) pages, plus Attachment 1. The parties have initialed each page.
11. The parties declare that they have full authority to enter into this Agreement, have fully understood the terms, and have voluntarily entered and accepted the settlement. The Union's representative whose signature appears below represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this settlement on behalf of the Union and all FCC Pollock bargaining unit employees represented by Local 1034 and has full authority to enter into the settlement with the promises, obligations, and considerations contained herein. The Agency's representative whose signature appears below represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this settlement on behalf of the Agency and has full authority to enter into the settlement with the promises, obligations, and considerations contained herein.




