DURATION OF AGREEMENT

<u>Section 25.1.</u> This Agreement remains in effect from the date of execution through the 7th of March, 2021, and for successive periods of one (l) year thereafter unless notice is given in accordance with this Article. All first-year economic improvements become effective September 13, 2017.

<u>Section 25.2</u>. Either party may reopen this Agreement for revisions or termination between the 60th and 120th day prior to each anniversary date of this Agreement Notification must be in writing delivered in person or sent by U.S. Certified Mail -Return Receipt requested.

<u>Section 25.3.</u> Copies of the Collective Bargaining Agreement shall be printed on 8.5"x 11"paper with the Company picking up 25% of the cost. Distribution will be made by the Union during duty hours IAW CBA Article 8.7.
