Memorandum of Understanding between National Archives and Records Administration and American Federation of Government Employees Council 260

The parties previously agreed, in our agreement dated April 4, 2022, to reinstate Federal Records Center Program (FRCP) production standards and productivity awards. Paragraph 4 of the April 4, 2022 agreement states that the agreement will expire on March 31, 2023 and provides that the parties may extend the program by mutual agreement.

This Memorandum of Understanding supersedes Paragraph 4 of the original agreement and extends and modifies the original agreement as follows:

4. <u>Duration.</u> This agreement and its terms are effective until a new National Agreement between the parties enters into force. The parties may extend the assessment period, make changes to the program, or end the program at any time by mutual agreement. In the event that this agreement is either ended early or allowed to expire, FRCP employees will be eligible for productivity awards for work completed through the end date or date of expiration. NARA will take actions necessary to determine eligibility, process awards, and report on productivity and awards issued, even though that work must necessarily be completed after the end date or expiration date.
