The Federal Labor Relations Authority has found that the Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Prisons, Federal Correctional Complex, Coleman, Florida, violated the Federal Service Labor-Management Relations Statute (Statute), and has ordered us to post and abide by this Notice.

WE HEREBY NOTIFY OUR EMPLOYEES THAT:

WE WILL NOT fail or refuse to comply with an arbitrator's award to return to the status quo.

WE WILL return to the status quo, with respect to arming both officers that escort high security inmates for medical purposes.

WE WILL NOT, in any like or related manner, interfere with employees in the exercise of their rights assured by the Statute.
