



Convention Primer

Nominations

As per the AFGE constitution, all nominations for national office must be made in writing, signed by the delegate making the nomination, and stating the name of the candidate and the office for which they are nominated. Nominations must be submitted to the Election Committee or Election Committee Chair, located in the Versailles Ballroom, before 4 p.m. Monday. No person may be a candidate for more than one office.

Orientation for New Delegates

If you've never been to an AFGE Convention, the experience can be a lot to take in. That's why AFGE will offer a choice of two in-person orientation sessions Sunday for first-time delegates and alternative delegates to help them prepare. These sessions explain how AFGE conducts business using Robert's Rules of Order, how to be recognized on the floor, and the rules governing debate and voting. Attendance is not mandatory but is strongly encouraged. Session 1 is 9:30-11 a.m. Sunday and Session 2 is 4-5:30 p.m. Sunday, both in Palace 4-6.

Elections

The election of officers for National President, National Secretary-Treasurer, and National Vice President for Women and Fair Practices will take place from 7:30-11:30 a.m. Wednesday in the Versailles Ballroom. Election results will be posted outside the election area and throughout the convention area Wednesday afternoon. Should any runoff be required, it will be held Wednesday afternoon. The time for the runoff will be posted.

Guest Badges and Seating

A registered delegate must sponsor guests who wish to observe the convention. Observer seating is limited and will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Lunch sessions are not open to guests. Guest badges must be obtained Saturday or Sunday from the guest badge table in the Check-In/Exhibit area, located in the Champagne Ballroom.
