What is AFGE-PAC?

AFGE-PAC is a non-partisan political action committee that fights for workers' political power. It is your chance to have your voice – and the issues you care about – heard at the local, state, and national levels of government. Your voluntary contribution to AFGE-PAC goes toward campaigns and candidates that defend the rights of D.C. and federal workers.

National Victories

The Largest Federal Pay Raise in 43 Years

In 2024, AFGE successfully secured a 5.2% pay raise in the federal budget – the largest federal pay raise in 43 years. This sizable pay raise bucked decades of austerity-driven policies that placed government salaries significantly behind their private-sector counterparts. Getting the pay raise was the result of coordinated grassroots pressure on both parties and the strategic use of AFGE-PAC contributions to increase allied margins in Congress.

Defeated Biden's VA Privatization Scheme

AFGE led the fight against the Biden Administration's 'AIR Commission' to downsize and close VA facilities across the country in a clear move toward eventual privatization of the VA health system. This horrible proposal initially had widespread support in Congress, and AFGE mounted a large-scale "Save my VA!" pressure campaign on Democrat and Republican elected officials to stop the privatization scheme. In the end, a bipartisan group of 12 senators blocked the AIR Commission and saved thousands of VA jobs.

National Fights

Securing a Full and Functioning FLRA

For years, Republican lawmakers have attempted to use procedural tricks to prevent the Federal Labor Relations Authority (FLRA) from having a fully functioning board so that it cannot weigh in on behalf of workers. A weak FLRA means less implementation of pro-labor laws, less challenges to agencies' unfair labor practices (ULPs), and more. AFGE is pressuring Administration officials and lawmakers to fill the FLRA, fund it, and empower it to defend workers' interests.

Electing Pro-Worker and Pro-AFGE Elected Leaders

Since 2020, AFGE has endorsed over 600 candidates for public office – and is proud to say that over 80% of those candidates won their campaigns. These victories were a direct result of volunteer mobilizations on the ground and AFGE-PAC investments into allied, critical campaigns.


More Political Fights!

Restoring Union Rights for all D.C. and Federal Workers

The Trump Administration committed the single-largest attack on unions in U.S. history by signing an Executive Order that removed collective bargaining rights for over 1 million federal workers. Overnight, collective bargaining agreements (CBAs) at dozens of government agencies were torn up and AFGE lost two-thirds of our members. In response, AFGE is rebuilding its internal infrastructure and its external political power. We are mounting a campaign to deliver electoral justice in the upcoming elections, and we need dedicated volunteers and AFGE-PAC funds to take the fight to anyone standing in our way.

Kicking Out Unreliable Politicians

For far too long we have seen politicians in both parties ignore the needs of working families. Many elected officials have been taking our membership's service for granted, only to turn around and privatize our jobs or cut our pensions. We will no longer accept this. AFGE is engaging in contested elections to actively support and elect pro-worker candidates willing to fight – not just talk and pay lip-service – to working people, in place of politicians who have sided with Wall Street instead of working families.
