

## Here's what you should know about job-related injuries:

- An injured federal employee is allowed to see any physician.
- You are not required to go to a specific clinic, or a clinic recommended by TSA.
- Your physician may be in a private practice, health maintenance organization (HMO), or employed by a federal agency.
- Any qualified physician may provide the initial treatment of your work-related injury, including an emergency room doctor.
- If you elect to visit a TSA-recommended physician or clinic, the outcome may not be as fair and consistent as an independent provider due to the conflict of interest.

AFGE recommends you visit an independent physician of your choice for workers' compensation cases.
