

As TSA officers, we are the first line of defense for aviation security. We protect passengers, pilots, flight attendants, and our country. We are an integral part of our national security framework and deserve fair workplace rights.

Did you know?

- In 2018, we protected our country by stopping a record-number 4,239 firearms from getting on airplanes.
- We remained on the job to keep passengers safe without pay during the longest government shutdown in history.
- Despite our dedication to public safety, we are among the lowest paid federal workers.
- We are denied full overtime pay, because TSA refuses to follow the Fair Labor Standards Act like other federal agencies.
- The law creating TSA allows the agency to interpret its obligations under the Rehabilitation Act differently than other federal agencies.
- Due to staffing shortages, female TSA officers are limited to certain shifts and duties at some airports.
