

Tell Your Lawmakers to Support the VA Employee Fairness Act of 2019



It's time to give all VA employees the same bargaining rights and an equal voice in the workplace.

- Collective bargaining rules for VA medical professionals have been interpreted and applied by the VA in an arbitrary and unfair manner since 2003 – an untenable situation that's only been made worse by recent union-busting executive orders and management actions.
- To address these issues, Rep. Mark Takano (CA) and Sen. Sherrod Brown (OH) have introduced the VA Employee Fairness Act of 2019 as H.R. 1133 and S.462, respectively.
- This legislation restores collective bargaining rights to frontline clinicians including physicians, registered nurses, dentists, physician assistants, podiatrists, optometrists, chiropractors and expanded-function dental auxiliaries.
- It also allows the union to hold the VA accountable for following their own policy as it relates to employee compensation, peer review, and patient care and competence.
