Dear Mr. Secretary:

The COVID-19 crisis engulfing the Nation has called for sacrifices by many federal employees. At the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Transportation Security Officers (TSOs), law enforcement officers and other front-line employees are often in close contact with persons who are suffering from the effects of COVID-19. Because of their heroic efforts, too many of these employees have fallen ill with the COVID-19 virus, and some have even died.

Therefore, we request that in recognition of the ultimate sacrifice made by DHS employees, including TSOs and law enforcement personnel, who, while serving their Country, have died as a result of COVID-19 infection, that you as Secretary, utilize your authority under the Civilian Service Recognition Act of 2011, Pub. L. 112-73, to present a United States flag to the beneficiary of the deceased as a way to formally express sympathy and gratitude on behalf of the Nation.

The current crisis has highlighted the work and severe sacrifices made by so many federal employees. It is only fitting that those who have fallen as a result of their dedication to duty be recognized accordingly.
