Here's how we put your PAC dollars to work:

Fighting for Increased Pay:

- We're working hard to secure a 3.0% increase to your pay in 2019.
- We won federal employee pay parity with military employees in FY 2017.

Wins in the President's Budget:

- While the current budget isn't perfect, we beat back cuts to agencies as high as 30% of total agency budgets.
- We secured \$296 billion in agency funding.

Pushing Back on Anti-Federal Employee Budget Proposals:

- We defeated cuts to federal employee compensation and benefits in the FY 2018 budget and final spending measure.

Creating Allies for all Agencies: We use PAC dollars to create allies for all agencies. Here are a few examples of bills and wins that were made possible by your support.

BOP

- Keeping officers safe by fighting for legislation that created better working conditions, such as the ability to carry pepper spray, and utilize gun lockers onsite.
- Secured \$33 million for additional officers in all high security housing units.

EPA

- Fought off a proposed 30% cut to the overall EPA budget.

DHS

- Fought for Gerardo Hernandez Airport Security Act, a bill requiring **TSA** to conduct biannual active shooter training and exercises.
- We successfully advocated for the inclusion of **FEMA** pay language in the FY2018 Omnibus bill.
- Stopped the privatization of 1200 **TSA** screeners at Orlando International Airport.

Federal Firefighters

- Passed in the House the Fire Fighter Cancer Registry Act which established a CDC registry of incidents of cancer among fire fighters.

DOD

- We secured the A-76 moratorium on contracting out DOD work.
- Successfully stopped any planning or executing of a BRAC facility closures.

VA

- Won VA-specific provisions requiring minimum nurse-patient staffing ratios.
- Prevented the elimination of official time, anti-labor and union dues provisions.

SSA

- Secured a funding increase of \$480 million for the Social Security Administration for the FY2018 Omnibus, the first time in nearly 10 years.

Federal Law Enforcement Officers

- Secured the FERS Supplemental insuring pay for retired LEOs.
